April 13: Steer Weigh & Tag Day @ Fairgrounds | 8am-Noon
April 15: Spring Clean-Up @Fairgrounds |6pm
May 31: Online Registration Closes for large animals
June 1: Sheep Weigh & Tag Day @ Fairgrounds | 8am – Noon
June 1: Goat Weigh & Tag Day @ Fairgrounds | 8am – Noon
June 1: Swine Tag Pickup @ Fairgrounds | 8am-Noon
July 1: Small Animal Registration Closes

4-H Club Leaders and FFA Advisors: Please create a registration for your club or chapter using your **Club name** as the exhibitors "**First Name**" and "**4-H**" or "**FFA**" as the exhibitor's "**Last Name**". Example: First Name: "Grandview", Last Name: "FFA". Please use a correct mailing address as this is where the premium check for your club/chapter will be sent. Once you've created the club/chapter as the exhibitor, please register for Herdsmanship in each species your club/chapter has exhibitors participating. You may also register your chapter's educational display/agricultural booth at this time (if you have one).

Registration Checklist:

- Please register livestock animals **BEFORE** weigh/tag day
- Do not wait until the last minute to register – leave time to ask questions or to combat slow connections.
- Verify exhibitor Mailing Address – this is the address that will be used when generating checks after the fair.
- Register for RV pass (only register for one RV pass per family), extra wristbands, or extra parking passes as needed. – Remember: Each exhibitor will receive a wristband, *and* each family receives one parking pass. This step is solely for extras.
- Each livestock exhibitor **MUST** be registered for their 1) market or breeding class, 2) a Record Book, and 3) Fitting and Showing for each species being shown.

* Small Animal Registration will remain open through July 1st.

* Still life exhibits (Photography, Baking, Sewing, Fashion Review, Public Presentations, etc) can be added when registering livestock OR be added later. This registration remains open until fair week*

Please remember: Before payment is processed, each entry submitted will be approved by our sale coordinator. You may receive your registration back in order to correct it before it can be accepted. Last year, the most common reason for returned registrations was forgetting to register for Fitting and Showing or a Record Book.

We look forward to having you at the fair (August 7th - 10th) this year!
